Stage & Room Setup



 \cdot The stage should ideally be 1 or 2 feet off the ground, and 12 to 25

feet wide.

·An access ramp is required, since Scott presents in a wheelchair (stage right or

left is preferred). Some groups prefer that Scott enters from the back of the

stage. If you are having difficulties sourcing an access ramp, Scott is okay

having two people lift him onto the stage.

Scott prefers NO RAILINGS on the access ramp whenever possible. Most

hotels venues can comply; if issues arise, rails are acceptable.
