- ·Where controllable, have the audience as close to the stage as possible.
- ·What on podium or high table

Room Layout:

- ·Round or square tables cabaret style is preferred.
- •Theatre style when audience too big to be at tables.
- ·Avoid classroom and U-Shape layouts where possible.
